- a) The dropped kerb application for permissions to create a new access off the highway from Cow Lane has been approved by NYCC.
- b) The Clerk advised that there wasn't a legal agreement for the new access with the seller of the play field however, it had been a requirement of the purchase and it was informally agreed that a new entrance will be provided as soon as possible. The current original side gate opening provides an entrance and exit onto private land which the Parish Council has no control over.
- c) Advice was sought by the Clerk from the Local Council Advisory Service and RoSPA. Neither could grant legal advice but both advised that the Parish Council should organise its own risk assessment. It was **RESOLVED**: That RoSPA be asked to provide a risk assessment at a cost of £232.00. This would ensure an independence opinion on the current opening and the proposed opening would be obtained.
